This letter is a follow up to the email sent to you on November 14, 2018, in response to the letter dated November 8, 2018 from Birgit Sale, Foreperson, stating that the Centralia School Districts responses are: "... deficient pursuant to Penal Code Section 933.05(b) as it applies to missing time frame compliance for: R4."

Our letter to The Honorable Charles Margines dated July 17, 2018 and signed for by a representative of the Court on July 19, 2018, responds to R.4. as follows: "The recommendation will be fully implemented in 2018-19 utilizing a new visitor sign in system."

As of this date, Centralia School District has implemented the Raptor Sign-In system at all of our elementary schools. The system requires visitors and volunteers to scan their driver's license and runs it through a database prior to printing a photo identification badge for that person. Each time that person visits the campus, a new badge with the current date is printed. With this system, we believe the Centralia School District is in full compliance of Grand Jury recommendation R4.
