Re: Orange County Grand Jury Recommendations on Sex Trafficking of Girls  
Penal Code 933 and 933.05

In response to the Grand Jury report dated June 19, 2012, we have reviewed the recommendations and respectfully submit our response as follows:

**R1:** The Brea Police Department has conducted formal training in sex trafficking (adult and juvenile) to all Investigations Division detectives. Additional uniformed department personnel have attended POST-certified training courses. Advanced Officer training opportunities are offered and available to all sworn personnel through outside agency POST-certified training courses upon request.

**R2:** The Brea Police Department has documented no such cases of sex trafficking for adults or juvenile victims. In the event of such a documented violation, our records management system (Intergraph) is capable of marking and identifying cases for statistical data and tracking for future reference.

**R3:** In the event of any cases involving sex trafficking of adults or juvenile victims, the Brea Police Department shall refer to California Penal Code section 1275.1 when there is cause to believe that the source of bail money for a “pimp” or “john” was illegally obtained.
